

Dear Parents of Seventh Grade Students:

This year we are excited to offer a three-day, two night Leadership School experience at Camp Kieve to seventh grade students in the Windsor and York houses. Camp Kieve is located in Nobleboro, Maine, and their staff will be working closely with the King Middle School teachers to provide our students with an outstanding experience. The Leadership Program at Camp Kieve has a national reputation, and we are thrilled that our students will be heading there this October.

The following areas will be the focus of our work at Camp Kieve:

- to encourage responsible decision-making
- to focus on building/maintaining healthy relationships
- to broaden and raise aspirations
- to improve social competencies

The students will participate in five classes per day including classes on decision making, relationships, communication skills, goal setting and a ropes course. The classes use the experiential education model and are designed to promote discussion and involve all students. These experiences are aligned with the Maine Learning Results and have been coordinated with the King staff, as well. Follow-up activities will take place in their house classes as well as through the physical education program at King.

The dates for the trip are October 21-23, 2009. Both York-7 and Windsor-7 will be attending at the same time, and house teachers will be on site throughout the experience. As you can imagine, the cost for such an experience is quite high. We are hoping each family could contribute \$50.00 towards the cost of this trip, and we thank you in advance for this support.

A representative from Camp Kieve will be at King the evening of our Open House in September. There will be a short presentation and a chance for questions. We have attached all of the necessary permission slips and ask you to return them to school as soon as possible. You will also find a packing list and a map of the location attached. 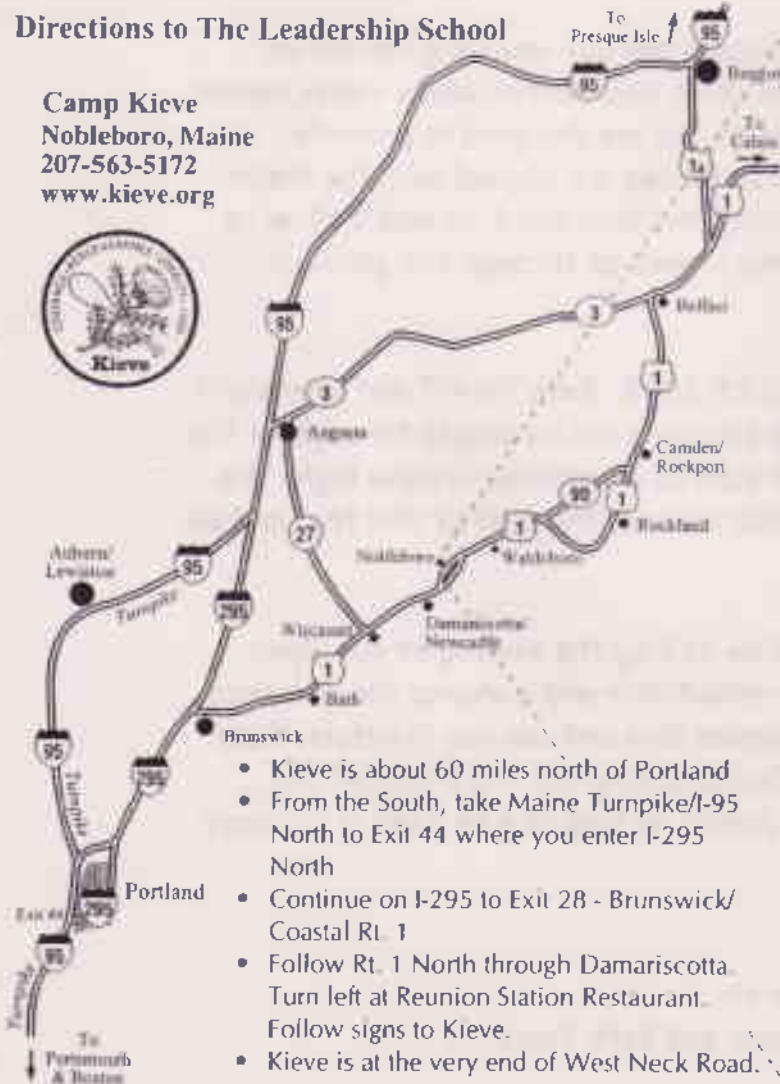

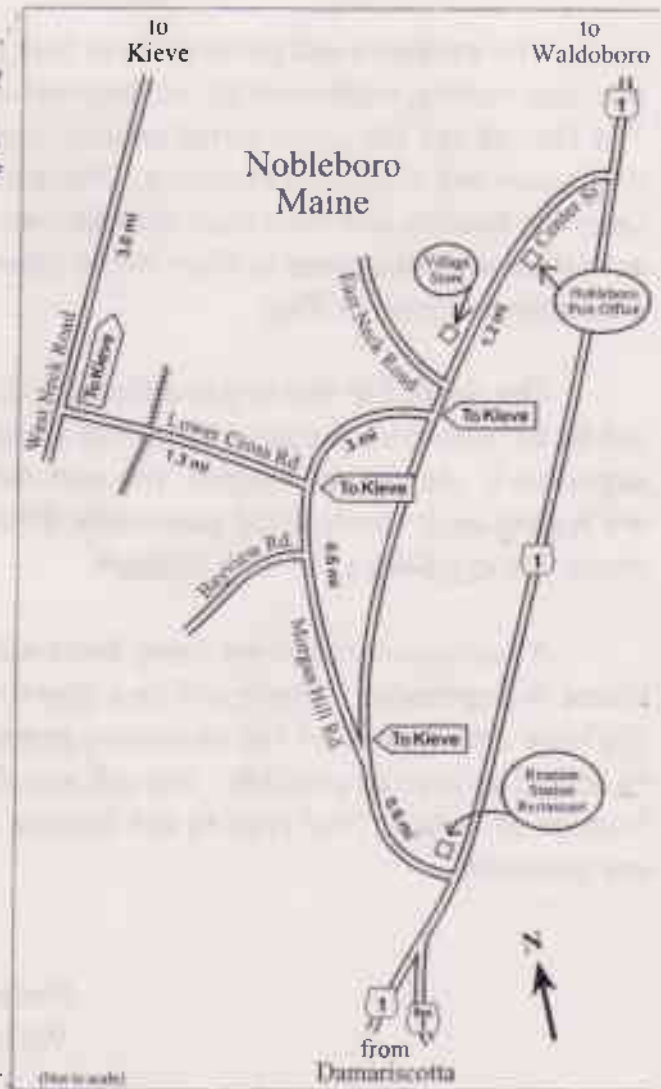
