Dear King families,

As we shared on Wednesday night, we are excited to be able to open and welcome our students back to school next week. On Monday, September 14th our A day students will be in session. On Tuesday, September 15th our B day students will be in session. The school day begins at 9:45 and ends at 2:30.

Teachers have been working very hard to prepare for the start of the year and are very excited for students to return to school. The halls and classrooms of King are welcoming and we are all longing to have students back in our building.

Please remember to complete the symptom check before sending your student to school. A reminder will be sent daily at 6AM through an email and text. You must respond to the questions indicating that you have completed the symptom check and submit it. If a student arrives at school without the symptom check submitted they will not be able to enter the building until we complete the screening.

If you're unsure about sending your student to school, please keep the student home and call the office to speak with the nurse or call the student's health care provider.

When students arrive on campus they should follow the signs to enter the building through the entrance designated for their team (see photo). King staff will be outside to welcome students and help them find their entrance.
