I hope that everyone enjoyed the long weekend and observance of Veteran's Day. There is certainly a lot happening within the walls of King, especially as we head toward portfolio conferences next week. Please take advantage of the opportunity to hear first-hand from your student on the progress they are making toward targets and standards.



Last week we hosted our annual Fall Institute. 40 visitors from different states on the east coast for two full days of professional development. 30 students participated in the Institute. They provided tours and presented their work. The visitors were very impressed with our students and their ability to articulate their learning.

Expeditions:

On Thursday, Windsor 8 and York 6 students attended a student performance of Portland Ovation's Living Voices: Within the Silence. The show, performed at USM, looked at the the impact World War II had on Japanese-Americans and the history of anti-Asian sentiment in the United States. The show had direct connections to each team's expeditions: Y6's *Words to Live By*, as well as W8's *Truth or Consequences*.
